

Rutland Sailability (RS) Covid-19 Up-date September 2020

After conducting a detailed RS Covid-19 Risk Assessment and planning the necessary risk mitigation, Thursday sailing recommenced on July 30th.

Whilst we cannot promise 100% Covid-19 safe, we do meet the legal definition of a 'Covid-19 secure' organised sporting activity.

Unfortunately, to maintain 2 metre social distancing, this has been restricted to sailors with a disability who can get in & out of a boat independently or assisted by someone from their same household **and** can confidently sail solo.

We plan to continue until the last Thursday in October but this is weather dependent. Apart from access to two 'disabled' toilets, we are operating entirely outside. If conditions become too cold or wet, we do not plan to go inside the clubhouse.

To date, the very real benefits to health & well-being have far out-weighed the additional challenges overcome by all who have participated.
