

Rutland Sailability (RS) Covid-19 - Update November 2020

After conducting a detailed RS Covid-19 Risk Assessment and planning the necessary risk mitigation, Thursday sailing recommenced on July 30th.

Whilst we could not promise 100% Covid-19 safe, we did meet the legal definition of a 'Covid-19 secure' for an organised outdoor sporting activity.

Unfortunately, to maintain 2 metre social distancing, this had to be restricted to sailors with a disability who could get in & out of a boat independently or assisted by someone from their same household **and** could confidently sail solo.

We managed to deliver ten RS Sailing Days before the second shutdown in November. Unfortunately, we will not be running our winter programme of speakers, training or social activities as this would involve meeting indoors.

Hopefully, we will re-open sailing in April 2021 and, dependent upon the Covid risk declining, slowly expand our sailing & other activities back towards a 'new normal'.
